4.1 Increase alignment of resources to reflect the needs identified in strategic plan

We utilize Grant funding to support our growth in sustainability and aid in capitol refresh of equipment with the grant funds.



# **Background**

In 2024, the Thompson School District received two grants to pilot electric buses: EPA Clean School Bus and CDPHE Clean School Bus.

- The grant is the Colorado Electric School Bus Grant through the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment (CDPHE).
- TSD applied in June 2023 and received the initial preliminary award August 2023 for 2 grants (CDPHE and Drive Clean CO)
- State has been working through the contract process; TSD received the finalized contract in November 2024 for approval
- CDPHE award: \$854,000--this was based on established grant maximums (more info below)

TSD was awarded funding for 3 Type A buses and 3 Level 3 DC chargers through these grants.
